

FALL PANC 2010



- Team Teaching
 - Coded in NCWISE by listing the teachers name in the Teacher 1 and Teacher 2 fields on the Course Section Maintenance screen
 - Equal Responsibility in the classroom
- Co-Teaching (Inclusion Teacher, Cooperative Teacher, Curriculum Assistant)
 - Co-teachers are coded in NCWISE on the Other Staff screen accessed through Course Section Maintenance.



- In terms of HQ what's the difference
 - Team teachers are both analyzed and if one or both teachers make the class HQ then the class is deemed HQ.
 - Co-Teachers are not analyzed for HQ
- EC Extend Subjects
 - 93xx are for high school
 - 94xx are new and are for middle school



- 93xx/94xx EC Extend Subjects
 - Require an HQ EC license area to match one child's disability in the class
 - Students in these subjects do not need content above the 6th grade level
- Other Rules
 - 80% or more EC students in a class then the class is deemed EC



Other Rules Continued

- If you code a class as a X for 9-12 and 51% or more students in the class are coded as grade level 6-9 then the class is deemed a 9th grade class, then the 6-9 or 9-12 license area can cover the class
- If you code a class as a Y and 51% or more students in the class are coded as grade level of K-6 then the class is deemed a 6th grade class, then the K-6 or 6-9 area can cover the class



- Common Questions
 - How does an EC student get coded as Cross Category?
 - If you code a student in a class that is deemed EC but you did not code one of the students with an EC type then SAR codes the disability as CC



- Common Questions
 - OCS Classes what options do I have?
 - Team Teach the class with an HQ EC teacher that matches the disability of one student in the class and HQ subject teacher or an NCVPS Subject teacher.
 - Praxis test or by completing 24 semester hours in the subject area with a grade of "C" or better in the subject area.

- Name change Please submit one of the following legal documents along with the request
 - marriage certificate
 - copy of new SSN card
 - driver's license
 - passport
- \$55.00 non-refundable processing fee for any variation of an educator's license. This includes, but is not limited to, the deletion of a license area. (115C-296 (a2))

- 30 Business Day Processing clock begins with the received date shown under pending information in LicSal
- Licensure Newsletter sent in October- if you did not receive it contact RALC Coordinator and any feedback can be directed to them
