Individuals who have been employed on an emergency permit (with at least a 2.5 grade point average, but inappropriate college major) may be issued a lateral entry license upon the recommendation of the LEA and satisfactory completion of the NC TEACH Summer Institute. All requirements to convert the lateral entry license to a Standard Professional license must be completed within three years. The year of teaching on the emergency permit counts as the first year of lateral entry licensure.
