Overview of School Activity Report (SAR) Data And the NCLB In-field/Out-of-field Process

Overview

1. The School Activity Report (SAR) data contains information about professional school personnel (principals, assistant principals, counselors, teachers, etc.) and their activities. The following information is available in SAR for each activity: social security number, name, ethnicity, and gender for the professional person(s) associated with the activity, LEA code/school code for the school where the activity is occurring, subject matter covered in the activity, academic level and grade level at which the activity's subject matter is taught, duration of the activity, and counts by grade, ethnicity/gender and exceptionality type for students associated with the activity.
2. The SAR data comes from the SIMS and NCWISE applications. It is extracted at the end of a school's second month for the current school year. The data is sent to DPI, where it is edited and Exceptions reports are generated. These reports are made available via AS/400 or FTP to the LEAs and charter schools. The reports are reviewed and appropriate personnel are contacted to fix incorrect data. After corrections are made, another SAR extract is done for the schools requiring data corrections and is sent to DPI. This process is repeated until every LEA's and charter school's SAR data is correct and complete or until the SAR business owner decides to end the SAR Load Process for the school year. The Load Process usually begins in mid-October.
3. If a school has a multiple-track calendar and a teacher teaches in more than one track, their activities are reported using the Professional Personnel Activity Report (PPAR) form. This form was used prior to the implementation of SAR to gather school activity information for professional school personnel. We continue to use it because SIMS cannot handle multiple-

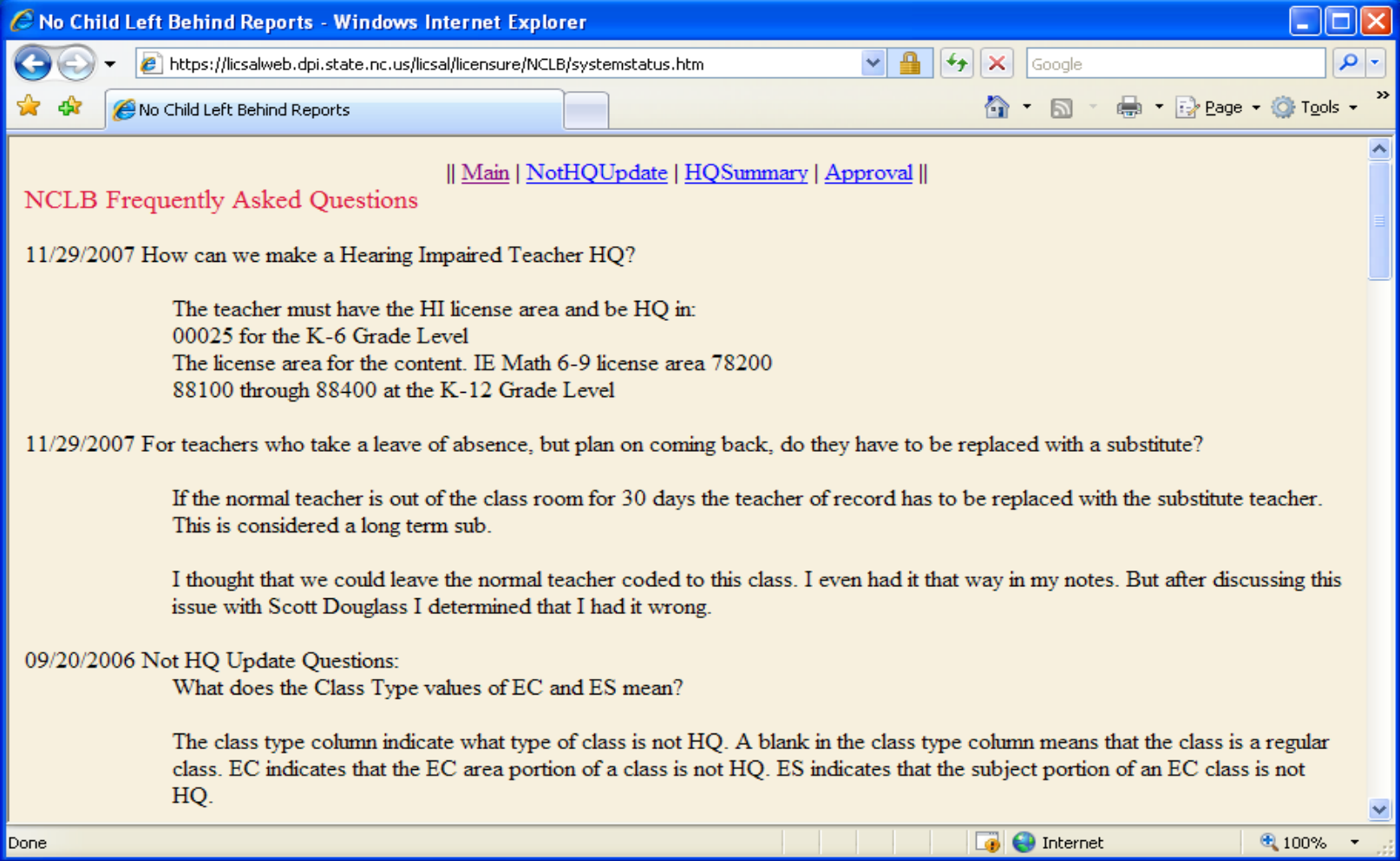

- How is a class determined EC?
 - 80% of the Students EC
 - Academic Level Zero
- What is required to match an EC area to a Teacher?
 - Teacher's EC area match the disability of one Student
 - Grades 7-12 requirements



NCLB

- Hearing Impaired Teachers
 - The teacher must have the HI license area and be HQ in:
 - 00025 for the K-6 Grade Level
 - The license area for the content. IE Math 6-9 license area 78200
 - 88100 through 88400 at the K-12 Grade Level



NCLB

- Why are resource teachers showing up on my NOT HQ Report?
 - Pullout class
Student Leaves
 - Co-Teaching
Teacher comes into the classroom



NCLB

- What do the Class Type values of EC and ES mean?
 - The class type column indicates what type of class is not HQ. A blank in the class type column means that the class is a regular class. EC indicates that the EC area portion of a class is not HQ. ES indicates that the subject portion of an EC class is not HQ.

- For teachers who take a leave of absence, but plan on coming back, do they have to be replaced with a substitute?
 - If the normal teacher is out of the classroom for >30 days the teacher of record has to be replaced with the substitute teacher.
- Can we get credit for an HQ teacher hired after SAR closed?
 - No, we have to close SAR to finalize the list of teachers.

TCP 1 – Requests for Waiver of the Repayment Obligation of the National Board Certification Participation Fee
Policy Implications: General Statute § 115C-296.2; SBE Policy # TCP-F-001

Presenter(s): Philip Price (Associate Superintendent, Financial and Business Services) and Danny Holloman (Manager, Center for Recruitment and Retention)

Description:
A teacher for whom the State pays the participation fee for National Board Certification who does not complete the process or who completes the process but does not teach in a North Carolina public school for at least one year after completing the process is required to repay the participation fee to the State. In compliance with GS 115C-296.2, the State Board of Education established an appeals process through which individuals could request waiver of the repayment obligation. The appeals of 38 teachers who did not complete the process and/or who did not teach the year following the process were considered by an appeals panel. Personnel issues related to the requests will be considered by the Board in closed session. Action on first reading is requested.

Recommendations:
That the recommendations of the appeals panel be approved.
